Global Partnership on Artificial Intelligence

The **Global Partnership on Artificial Intelligence (GPAI)** brings **countries and experts together** to **support and guide the responsible adoption of AI** while seeking to contribute concretely to the **2030 Agenda** and the **United Nations Sustainable Development Goals**.

GPAI is a **multistakeholder initiative** that aims at **bridging the gap** between **theory and practice** on **artificial intelligence**.

By embracing a **plurality of perspectives**, GPAI can deliver **better outcomes** than **any one country can accomplish alone**.

GPAI brings together **leading AI experts** from a wide range of sectors and a diversity of countries, and connects them with **like-minded governments**.

GPAI provide **decision-makers** with **AI solutions** that are **ethical, accessible and actionable** – and that can be used as a **force for good**.

GPAI Tokyo Summit

The **2022 GPAI Tokyo Summit** will bring together **countries** and **experts** to foster **international cooperation** on **AI-related priorities**.

This is GPAI's **third annual Summit** and it is taking place in **Tokyo, Japan** on **21-22 November 2022**.

At the **Summit**, **GPAI Working Groups** showcase **the latest developments** of their work in **four areas**:

- Responsible AI
- Data governance
- Future of work
- Innovation and commercialisation.

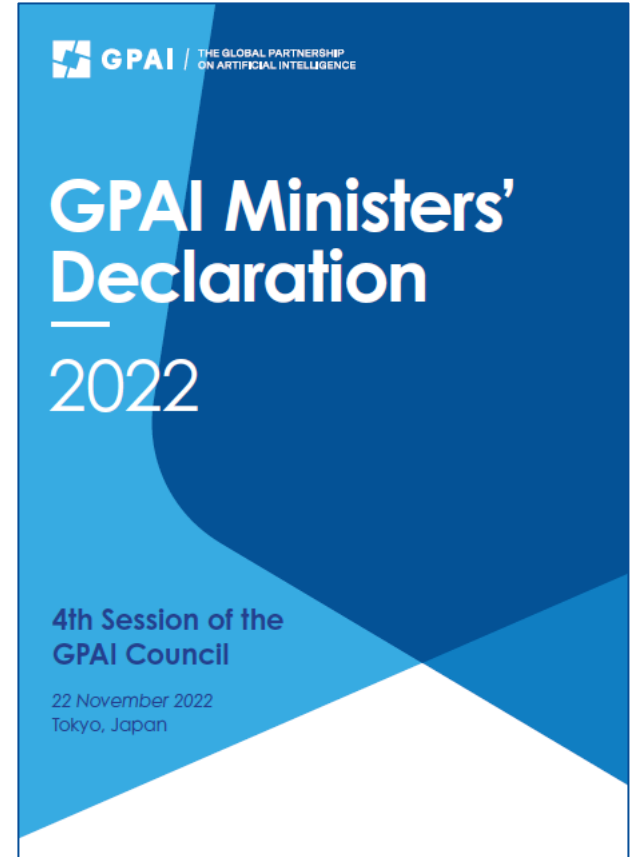

GPAl Ministers' Declaration 2022

Context

- **GPAl Ministers** will release a **declaration** at the end of the Summit reaffirming their **commitment to responsible AI** and **orienting priorities of GPAl**.
- The **Ministers' Declaration** is the **first set** of **GPAl collective messages** agreed upon by **all Members** since the launch in 2020.
- **Working Group** outputs are not collectively endorsed by **Members**, they reflect the **views of Experts** contributing to GPAl in their **individual capacity**. The declaration has been agreed upon by the **full GPAl Membership**, conveying its collective voice.

GPAI Ministers' Declaration 2022

Key messages (under embargo until 22 November 2022, 3PM JST)

We, Ministers of GPAI Members, reaffirm our commitment to the **OECD AI Principles** and to promoting **trustworthy, responsible and sustainable use** of **artificial intelligence**.

We affirm our commitment to protecting and promoting **human-centred values** and **democracy** that underpin an **inclusive, development-oriented, sustainable** and **peaceful society**.

We welcome **new Members** and confirm our joint commitment to **work together** with our **multistakeholder community** in committing to the **shared values** and **objectives of GPAI**.

We welcome the **Multistakeholder Experts Group participants' contributions** and the engagement of **Working Groups** to deliver their **work plan projects**.

We reaffirm our commitment to **GPAI's multistakeholder approach** and to promoting **stronger cooperation** between **public and private actors** working on **AI solutions** that **advance our common goals**.

We call on **countries that share the GPAI values to join us**. We will support GPAI's further **engagement** with other **international fora** including the G7 and G20.

We welcome the intention of **Japan**, Lead Chair for 2023, to promote **a resilient society** through **AI deployment** and **empowerment of citizens** under **GPAI priorities**.

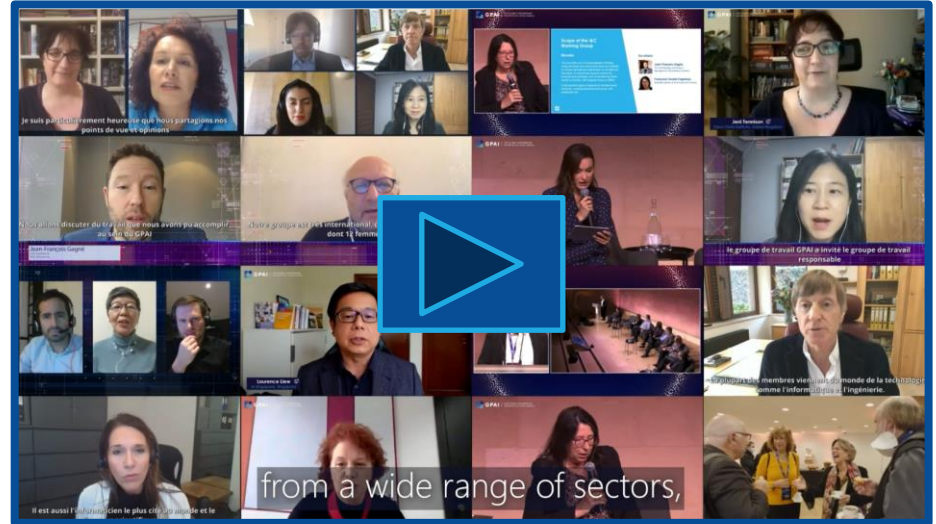

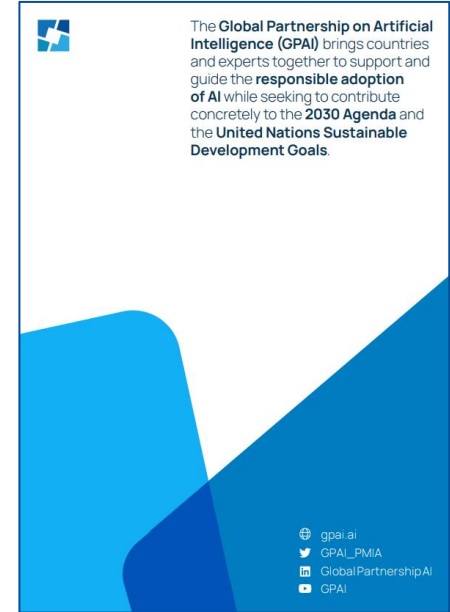
